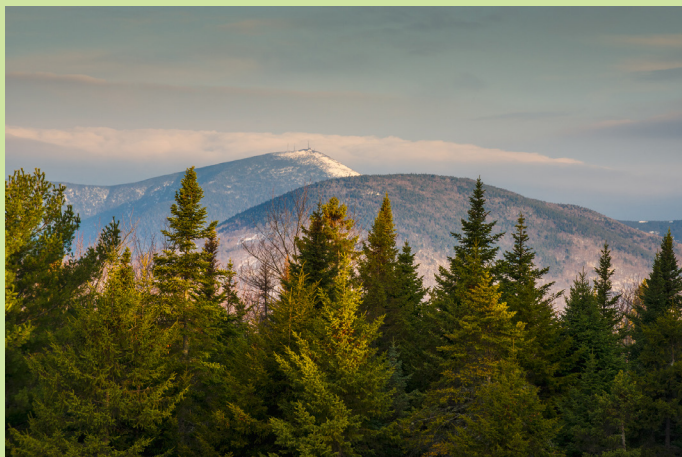


WELCOME to KINGFIELD!

KINGFIELD MAINE

Kingfield, incorporated in 1816, is a beautiful historic village set amid incredible scenery. Routes 27, 16 and 142 meet in the center of town, 20 miles north of Farmington and just south of Sugarloaf mountain. The High Peaks Scenic Byway begins here, traveling by mountains, rivers and the historic Arnold Trail before meeting the Canadian border, 40 miles north.

Hiking, skiing and mountain bike riding trails surround the town. Snowmobilers and ATV riders can park at the trailhead south of town, connecting from there to an intricate trail system that travels throughout the High Peaks region.

A designated Appalachian Trail Community, Kingfield provides the services, gear and resources needed for any outdoor adventure.
